RE: Country of Origin Marking Requirements
U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 19, Part 134, Country of Origin Marking
(hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations")

Dear Supplier,

It is imperative as a Supplier to Telect that you adhere to the above-referenced Regulations in regards to the Country of Origin markings on parts and packaging. Telect abides by these Regulations and we require this marking to be adhered by all of our Suppliers. Marking violations can be very serious and penalties from Custom authorities can be severe, including seizure of a shipment if marking violations or discrepancies are found.

Based on the seriousness of incorrectly declaring or marking a part's correct Country of Origin, Telect believes it is important that we communicate to our business partners, our Country of Origin requirements as indicated below.

Telect Supplier's must maintain identification of all parts and products through all stages of production and during transportation.

U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 19, Part 134, Country of Origin Marking, requires finished goods, parts, kits or assemblies to be marked with COUNTRY OF ORIGIN (i.e. "Made in XXXX"). Telect sources parts and products globally and these requirements must be adhered to in order to avoid Custom fines, penalties, or seizures of product shipping to a Telect location. Supplier shall comply with these U.S. Regulations for all shipments to Telect and/or to its customers.

Note: The XXXX letters need to be replaced with the COUNTRY in which the parts are manufactured as defined in the Country of Origin regulations, Part 134 listed above. Example markings: Made in Mexico; Made in USA; Made in China

- **Parts and Finished Goods Marking Requirement**

All parts/components/assemblies/kits, finished goods must be marked with the COUNTRY OF ORIGIN. Articles shall be marked in a conspicuous place as legibly, indelibly, and permanently as the nature of the article (or container) will permit, in such manner as to indicate to an ultimate purchaser in the United States the English name of the country of origin of the article, at the time of importation into the Customs territory of the United States. If part is too small, or would be damaged by applying the mark, the Country of Origin Marking can be placed on the immediate packaging of the article (ie. bag, box, tray, tube, etc).

- **Master Box Marking Requirement**

The COUNTRY OF ORIGIN must be marked on either the master box or shipping label.



- **Commercial Shipping Documents Marking Requirement**

The COUNTRY OF ORIGIN must be listed on commercial shipping documents.

Please return this letter signed and dated with your acknowledgement and acceptance of these requirements. Also please share these requirements throughout your facilities and your business partners who will be shipping product to Telect entities.
